- History and comorbidities

- Examination findings
- Investigations carried out and results
- Options already pursued
- Current medications
- Allergies
- Other important information e.g., social factors, other services involved

Reasons for referral

- Diagnosis
- Second opinion
- Review of treatment or care plan
- Specialist management
- Shared management with general practitioner
- Diagnostic procedure
